







Winter is Coming!

Winter weather and temperatures can take a toll on our water system here in Central Texas, as well as in your home! Check out some ways below that you can be sure you're ready for some frigid temps:

- Check Your Furnace: Furnace filters should be replaced every three months, and furnaces should be serviced regularly by pros to keep them running efficiently.
- **Keep Things Warm:** Set your thermostat to 50-55 degrees minimum to keep pipes from freezing when you're not home.
- Wrap Your Pipes: A burst pipe is very common and can be a very costly repair depending on the extent of the damage, luckily foam pipe insulation is a low-cost and readily available tool you can use to protect your home.
- Clean Your Gutters: Cleaning your gutters may not be top of mind when getting your home ready for the winter, but leaves and other debris from Fall can prevent a buildup of ice and snow in the gutter that can get up under roof shingles and cause leaks and damage on the inside of the house.
- Blow Out Your Sprinkler System: Protect your irrigation investment and underground hoses by blowing the water out of them before the first freeze. A sprinkler pro can come check your system and drain it so it is in top shape for spring, or a handy homeowner may be able to do this at home with an air compressor.






Another award for our wall! We are excited to share that Jonah Water has received the 2022 Texas Water Utilities Association award for Best Tasting Ground Water in the state!
